2018 FLINDERS COMMUNITY PROGRAM

Parents/Guardians have the option of either making a donation to the building fund or participating in the Flinders Community Program (FCP).

Capital Donation

Should Parents/Guardians wish to make a voluntary **Tax deductible Capital Donation of \$250.00** towards the Flinders Christian Community College Building Fund, please make your payment on the Community Portal. A Tax deductible receipt will be emailed in January.

Flinders Community Program

Should Parents/Guardians wish to participate in the FCP, please select one of the following options within the Community Portal. By selecting to participate in the Flinders Community Program a FCP levy of \$180.00 will be charged to your fees at the start of the year, which will be credited at the end of the year upon completion of your selected area.

- **Literacy / Classroom Assistance**
Assistance in the Junior School classes for at least 10 hours. This also includes Junior School sporting events.
- **Basketball Coaching or Team Management**
One whole season of uninterrupted coaching or team management. This is a seasonal arrangement and dependent on your child making a Flinders Basketball team. Information will be communicated through the College 'What's On' in February and August.
- **Parents and Friends**
Consistent service towards Parents and Friends fundraising activities, of at least 10 hours.
- **Perceptual Motor Program (PMP)**
10 hours of parental assistance for the Junior School PMP program. PMP is run for 45 mins once a week during Term 2 and 3.
- **Support for the Library**
Assistance in the Library 1 day per week for a double period (9-10.45am, 11am-12.45pm or 1.35- 3.15pm) with a one term commitment.
- **Assist in Kinder (Kinder families only)**
Sign up for 4 Kinder duties throughout the year. Each duty is from 9am – 12noon. Please register your days with your Kinder teacher.
- **Assist with Other Voluntary Work**
Significant contribution of hours to an event, activity or program. The hours must be pre-approved by the Campus Principal for inclusion as contributing to the FCP.
