What is a School Building Fund?

For Flinders Christian Community College to use the funds donated to the School Building Fund it must comply with rules set down by the Tax Office. They include:

"A school building Fund is solely for providing money for acquiring, constructing or maintaining the school buildings. It cannot be used for any other purpose.

Expenditure on capital improvements and maintenance, as well as installing and maintaining fixtures, are accepted outlays of a school building fund.

Costs payable from a school building fund include:

- Painting and general maintenance of school buildings and building insurance
- Constructions or purchase expenses, and
- Administrative costs of the fund, including bank fees and fundraising costs.

Costs that cannot be paid by a school building fund include running expenses of the school, paying teachers, buying furniture and materials and maintaining sports grounds and car parks."
